

Ashley Fendley Scholarship Humanitarian Award

Ashley Fendley was a sophomore at Bellaire High School when she suffered a fatal accident while snow skiing with her family during the 1999 Spring Break. She was a member of the National Honor Society and was actively involved in the arts. She valued human kindness, a striving for excellence, and an acceptance of others regardless of race, creed, or religious beliefs.

A few applicants will be selected to receive a \$2,000 scholarship. Some applicants will be awarded based on fine arts participation and others will be awarded based upon humanitarian qualities. This scholarship has been established to reward the attributes Ashley valued most.

General criteria for both scholarships are as follows:

- GPA at least 3.0
- Community service
- Financial need
- Strong work ethic
- Acceptance of others regardless of race, creed or religious belief
- Kindness toward others

The Humanitarian Award will be given to a student who has exhibited a strong interest in helping others.

IMPORTANT: The following must be submitted by the deadline date

1. Completed Application.
2. Teacher recommendation checklist in a sealed envelope (sealed and signed by the teacher).
3. Official transcript of high school courses for the four years in high school.
4. Essay, no more than 250 words, describing what you plan to do in the future to make a positive impact in the lives of others and why.
